## Peace of mind

We understand how important safety and security is to you, and our retirement schemes offer you extra reassurance to make life stress-free. All flats have an emergency call system which is manned day and night, so you can be safe in the knowledge that help is always at hand. You can go away for a few days without worrying, knowing that your home is in a secure building which is only accessible to residents.

We employ fully trained Scheme Managers, so that residents have a friendly face who can answer their questions, make sure their scheme is expertly managed, deal with emergencies and organise social activities.

## Affordable rents

All our properties offer affordable rents and all accommodation comes unfurnished which allows you to decorate your home to your own specification - after all it is YOUR home, not "a" home! Each flat is equipped with oven, hob and a fridge.

If you are receiving Housing Benefit your support charge is paid for by your Local Authority.



## Extra Care Housing

Henry Court, Dudley is a supported housing scheme consisting of 38 flats. All the flats have walk in showers. The building is built to Extra Care standards and has Communal lounges, dining area, full catering kitchen, craft room, guest room, laundry and hair dressing salon.

Henry Court has an excellent reputation within Dudley, both from Supporting People Team, Housing Department and Social Services. Social Services are using the Scheme as part of the training for Social Work students by having placements there.

At Henry Court we also work in partnership with the Afro-Caribbean Befriending Service who provide a day centre for our residents and a luncheon club.

## Henry Court facilities:

- **Supported independent living for frail and elderly residents over 55 years of age\***
- **38 Self contained, double glazed, centrally heated one & two bedroomed flats**
- **A real sense of community with a vast array of facilities including a quiet lounge, dining room, laundry room, library, craft room, and a hair salon.**
- **Assisted bathroom**
- **Landscaped gardens which residents can help maintain**
- **Organised social activities every month with on-site support**
- **All residents have a support plan that is reviewed quarterly or sooner if the need arises**
